

**JARDINS MAJORELLES GARTEN YSL MUSEUM
&
MARRAKECH PRIVATE TOUR**



LES REMPARTS DE MARRAKECH: Impossible not to see them: they surround the whole old town, with its 19 km long, and a wall which is generally 6 to 8 m high. 22 doors pierce the ramparts, letting people and cars pass. It is indeed the color of the earth in this place, which served and is still used for the construction of the various buildings of this city, which has today become one of the high places of tourism of Morocco, a pride for the country.





THE MAJORELLE GARDEN: The Majorelle garden is a tourist botanical garden of around 3000 species on nearly one hectare, named after its founder, the French painter Jacques Majorelle, who created it in 1931, inspiring oases, Islamic garden and Spanish-Hispano-Moorish garden. In 1980, the garden became a blue dream, thanks to the assistance of many artists and botanists dispatched by the designer Yves Saint-Laurent, new owner of the premises. When he died, his ashes were spread around a central villa. To date, the garden belongs to the Pierre Bergé - Yves Saint Laurent Foundation, and is one of the high places of tourism in Morocco with nearly 600,000 annual visitors.

MAJORELLE BLUE: The mixture of colors that we observe in this garden is essential to the atmosphere that emanates from it. You will obviously notice the dominant blue ... which influences your well-being and soothes you. Know that the Majorelle Blue, this bright blue that you will find throughout the property is a registered trademark ... When we see it, we understand better why.



THE BERBER MUSEUM: In the heart of the garden is also the Berber museum. This museum exclusively displays a collection of Berber objects from various regions of Morocco, from the Rif to the Sahara. Maps, explanatory texts - in French, English and Arabic -, photographs, archive films and audiovisual documents accompany visitors along the route.

THE YVES SAINT LAURENT MUSEUM: which opened its doors in October 2017 in the ocher city, thus won the prize for "best new public building" by the design magazine Wallpaper. "The Moroccan heritage of Yves Saint Laurent is now complete thanks to the opening of this elegant new museum dedicated to his life and his work," writes the Wallpaper. Located next to the Majorelle Garden, the 4000 m2 museum houses exhibition spaces, a research library and an auditorium.
